Clean Air Strategy

- Defra led but cross government - March 2019
- PM, NH₃, NO_X, SO_X, VOCs
- Ports to produce air quality strategy
- Clean Growth Strategy – decarbonise economy (support IMO targets)

Maritime 2050

- Launched Feb 18
- To report end 18?
- To 'ensure UK remains in the front rank of maritime nations....with a partnership between government and industry that is deep and genuine'
- Shipping's top priorities submitted in Sep 18



UK CHAMBER
of SHIPPING

Clean Maritime Council

- Launched 15 Oct 18
- ‘to devise a strategy to reduce GHG emissions from the sector and to improve air quality on and around our waterways, ports and shipping lanes’
- Short (to 2023), mid (to 2030) and long term (2030+) policy proposals
- Clean maritime plan to be published May 19

Industrial Strategy – sector deal

- 3 key areas – tech and innovation, attracting & retaining maritime business and coastal economic development
- 2 sided deal
- Industry currently bolstering the submission that will be drawn together by BEIS and DfT
- Ministerial clearance mid Jan 19
- Announcement 1 Feb 19
