For service onboard their Lighthouse Tenders on a fixed manning rota – 28 days duty followed by 28 days leave.

The NLB is the General Lighthouse Authority for Scotland and the Isle of Man, responsible in law for the provision and control of a network of marine aids to navigation – lighthouses, buoys, beacons and a precision satellite-based navigation service.

As Caterer you will assist in the provision of the full range of catering services essential to the efficient running of an NLB vessel including preparation of healthy meals and efficient operation of the Galley areas.

You will hold a valid Ships' Cooks Certificate and a valid MCA Medical Certificate (ENG 1). You will have previous experience working as a ships cook and will have undertaken Medical Care and ISPS training.

Flexibility and good interpersonal skills are essential, as is the ability to communicate at all levels within a small team environment.

The current pay band for a Caterer is £35,403 per year rising to £36,624 per year depending on qualifications and experience. Benefits package includes occupational sick pay scheme and a career average occupational pension scheme

There is also the opportunity to add real value to a professional organisation dedicated to the safety of those at sea, and to the protection of our maritime environment.
